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Size: 52"x 59" Quilt Construction

The quilt top is assembled using diamonds. Follow Step #1 and the Diamond Chart to make the diamond combinations.

Quilter Basics

Read instructions before beginning a project.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance.

22" measurement is approximate. WOF–approximately 40".

Diamonds: (A) Sew 2–6½" x WOF Print strips, right sides together, on the long sides. *Refer to the Diamond chart for the Print combinations & the number of strip sets.* (B) Align the 6½" line on a 60° Ruler with the edge of the strip set. Cut the triangle. (C) Flip the Ruler to the other side of the strip set. Cut the triangle. Continue flipping the Ruler across the strip set cutting the triangles. (D) Press the triangles open forming a diamond. *Refer to the chart for the number of diamonds.* Repeat to make all the diamond combinations.

2 Remove the stitching from 2 "C" diamonds, 2 "D" diamonds and 4 "B" diamonds. Set aside four Print 4 triangles and four Print 5 triangles. These will be used to assemble the quilt top.



Mark the ¹/₄" inch intersections on the diamonds to use for aligning the pieces.



Assemble the Blocks: (A) Sew Diamond D and Diamond F together. Sew Diamond E and Diamond C together. Combine the diamonds. Repeat to make 8 of Block A. (B) Sew Diamond B and Diamond A together. Make 2. Combine the diamonds. Repeat to make 8 of Block B.



Quilt Assembly_

Combine 2–Block A, 2–Block B, 1–Print 4 and 1–Print 5 triangle to make Column A. Make 2 of Column A. Combine 2–Block A, 2–Block B, 1–Print 4 and 1–Print 5 triangle to make Column B. Make 2 of Column B. Sew the four columns together.



6 Trim the top and bottom of the quilt top leaving a ¹/₄" seam allowance. *See diagram.*

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7 Add the 2¹/₂" wide Final Borders to the sides first then top and bottom. *Measure across the center of the top for the best length for the borders.* Use your appliqué method of choice to appliqué the elephant or giraffe to the quilt top. Join the 6–2¹/₂"x WOF binding strips.

Layer, quilt and bind the quilt. ENJOY!
