#### **Quilters Basics**

Read instructions before beginning a project.

All instructions include a ¼" seam allowance.

Press as you go. Press seams in one direction

22" measurement is approximate.

#### **CUTTING**



#### Fabric A, cut:

 $1 - 14\frac{1}{2}$ "x  $18\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle for Center Block.



#### Fabric E, cut:

 $2 - 5\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $24\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips for Wide Border.  $2 - 5\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $28\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips for Wide Border.



#### Fabric B, cut:

- 3 1"x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut 2 1"x  $48\frac{1}{2}$ " strips for sashing.
- 5 1"x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut 2 1"x  $45\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and 2 1"x  $44\frac{1}{2}$ " strips for sashing.
- 2 1"x  $24\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips for sashing.
- 4 1"x 28½" WOF strips for sashing.
- $1 1\frac{1}{2}$ "x WOF strips. Sub-cut  $2 1\frac{1}{2}$ "x  $18\frac{1}{2}$ " strips for Inner Border.
- $1 1\frac{1}{2}$ "x WOF strips. Sub-cut  $2 1\frac{1}{2}$ "x  $16\frac{1}{2}$ " strips for Inner Border.
- 1 1"x WOF strip. Sub-cut 4 1"x 10" strips for sashing.
- $6 2\frac{1}{2}$ "x WOF strips for the binding.



#### Fabric F, cut:

 $6 - 2\frac{1}{2}$ "x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut  $4 - 2\frac{1}{2}$ "x  $49\frac{1}{2}$ " strips for Outer Border.



#### Fabric G, cut:

4 - 2%"x WOF strips. Sub-cut 44 - 2%" squares for Pinwheel Blocks.



#### Fabric H, cut:

4 – 27/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut 44 – 27/8" squares for Pinwheel Blocks.



#### Fabric C, cut:

 $1 - 4\frac{1}{2}$ "x WOF strip. Sub-cut  $4 - 4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for Small Corner Blocks.



#### Fabric I, cut:

7 - 2%"x WOF strips. Sub-cut 88 - 2%" squares for Pinwheel Blocks.



#### Fabric D, cut:

1 - 10"x WOF strip. Sub-cut 4 - 10" squares for Large Corner Blocks.




#### SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

#### **Quilt Center**

Sew  $1 - \frac{1}{2}$ " x 18½" Fabric B strip to each side of the  $\frac{14}{2}$ " x 18½" Fabric A rectangle. Sew  $1 - \frac{11}{2}$ "  $x \frac{161}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).

#### Half Square Triangle Units

- Using a mechanical pencil draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 88 – 27/8" Fabric I squares.
- squares and 44 27/8" Fabric H squares.









- Stitch a scant 1/4" on opposite sides of the marked line (Fig. 2).
- Cut on marked line (Fig. 3) to yield 88 half square triangle units each from Fabrics G and Fabric H. Press away from background.
- Trim units to measure  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " with seams (Figs. 4 & 5).










Make 88 of Each

Trim to measure 2½"x2½" with seams.

#### Pinwheel Blocks

Stitch two H half square triangle units and two G half square triangle units together to make one pinwheel block (Fig. 6). Repeat to make 44 pinwheel blocks total.




Make 44

Blocks should measure 41/2" x 41/2" with seams.



#### Pieced Center Borders

Sew 5 pinwheel blocks together to make 1 inner Side Border (Fig. 7). Repeat to make a second inner Side Border.




Sew  $1 - 4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C square, 4 pinwheel blocks and  $1 - 4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C square together, in that order, to make one inner Top/Bottom Border. Repeat to make a second inner Top/Bottom Border (Fig. 8).




#### Pieced Outer Borders

1 Sew 7 pinwheel blocks together to make 1 strip. Sew 1 − 1"x 28½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of 1 − 5½"x 28½" Fabric E strip. Sew this strip to the bottom of the pinwheel block strip to make 1 outer Side Border (Fig. 9). Repeat to make a second outer Side Border.



2 Sew 6 pinwheel blocks together to make 1 strip. Sew this strip,  $1 - 1"x24\frac{1}{2}"$  Fabric B strip and  $1 - 5\frac{1}{2}"x24\frac{1}{2}"$  Fabric E strip together lengthwise and in that order to make 1 outer Top/Bottom section (Fig. 10). Repeat to make a second outer Top/Bottom section.



3 Sew 1 – 10" Fabric D square and 1 – 1"x 10" Fabric B strip, to opposite ends of the Top/Bottom Border section (Fig. 10). Then sew 1 – 1"x 44½" Fabric B strip to the "E" side of the Top/Bottom Border (Fig. 11). Repeat to make a second outer Top/Bottom border.






#### QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY \_

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

- Sew 1 inner Side Border to each side of the Center Block. Sew 1 inner Top/Bottom border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 2 Sew one outer Side Border to each side of the Center Block. Sew 1 outer Top/Bottom border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 3 Sew 1 1"x 48½" Fabric B strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew 1 1"x 45½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
- 4 Sew  $1 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x49½" Fabric F strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew  $1 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x49½" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.



**Quilt Layout** 

- 1 Layer and quilt as desired.
- 2 Sew the  $6 2\frac{1}{2}$ "x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 3 Bind as desired.
